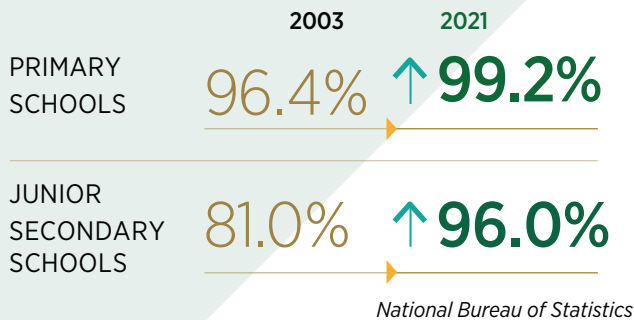

Program Cause

Education in Indonesia is showing much improvement in access, however more is needed to be done to improve the quality. The international assesment of student performance shows that the majority of Indonesian students performed below the minimum level of competency in literacy, numeracy, and science.

The Covid-19 Pandemic brought additional challenges to the effort to improve Indonesian education



646,200 or **97,6%** schools were closed

PINTAR (Phase I)

- Worked in 5 provinces: Riau, Jambi, North Sumatra, Central Java, and East Kalimantan
- Trained principals and teachers to improve teaching & learning, and school management
- Supported Teacher Training Institutes (TTIs) to adopt the more practice-oriented teacher education
- Extended technical assistance and professional development training for local and national governments
- Reached 1,397 primary and secondary schools

PINTAR (Phase II)

- Shifted PINTAR teacher professional development program from conventional face-to-face to digital based training
- Introduced e-PINTAR, an open and free online self-learning course for teachers across the nation
- Facilitated innovation at TTIs to improve teaching practicum in the pre-service teacher education
- Refunctioned PINTAR website to serve as online learning resource that provides teaching practical guides, ready-use lesson plans, student workbooks, reading books, and teacher training modules
- Activated parent involvement in student learning at home and school
- Added 263 partner schools under PINTAR-Penggerak Program

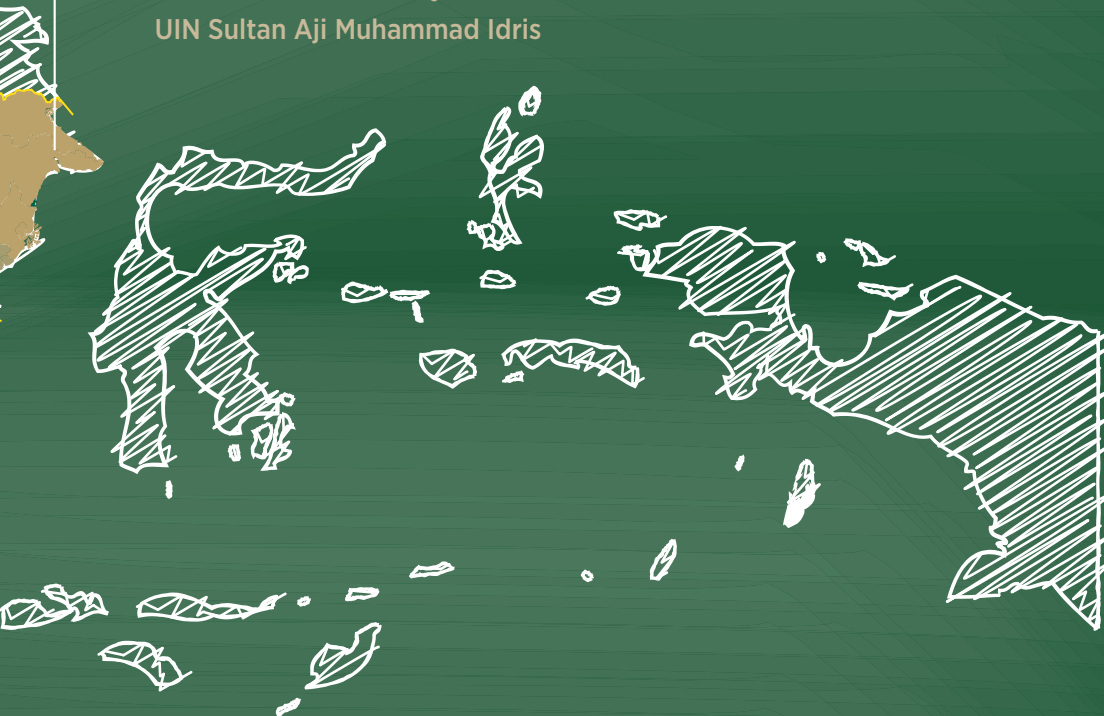

Work alongside the national and local governments in planning for education programs, developing sound policy, and disseminating good practices in school development.

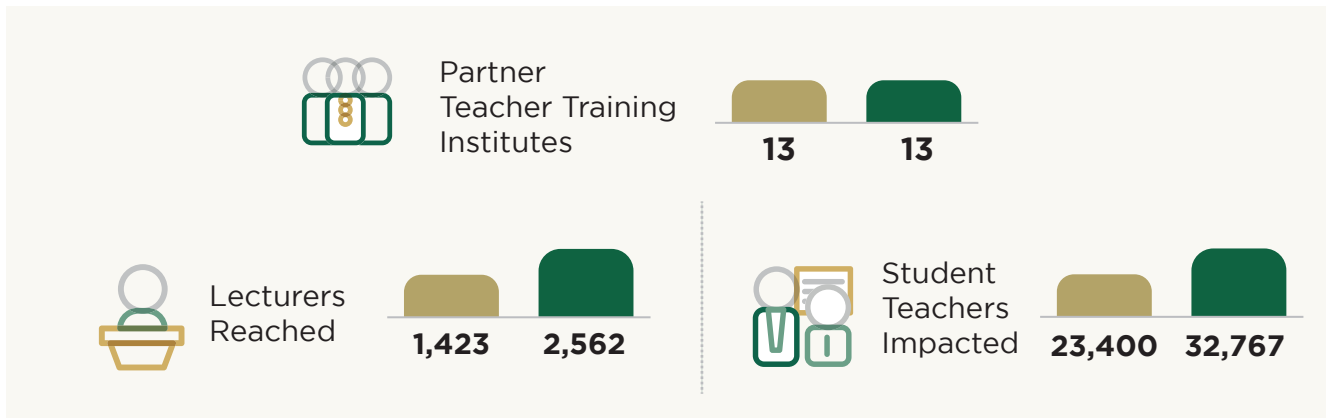
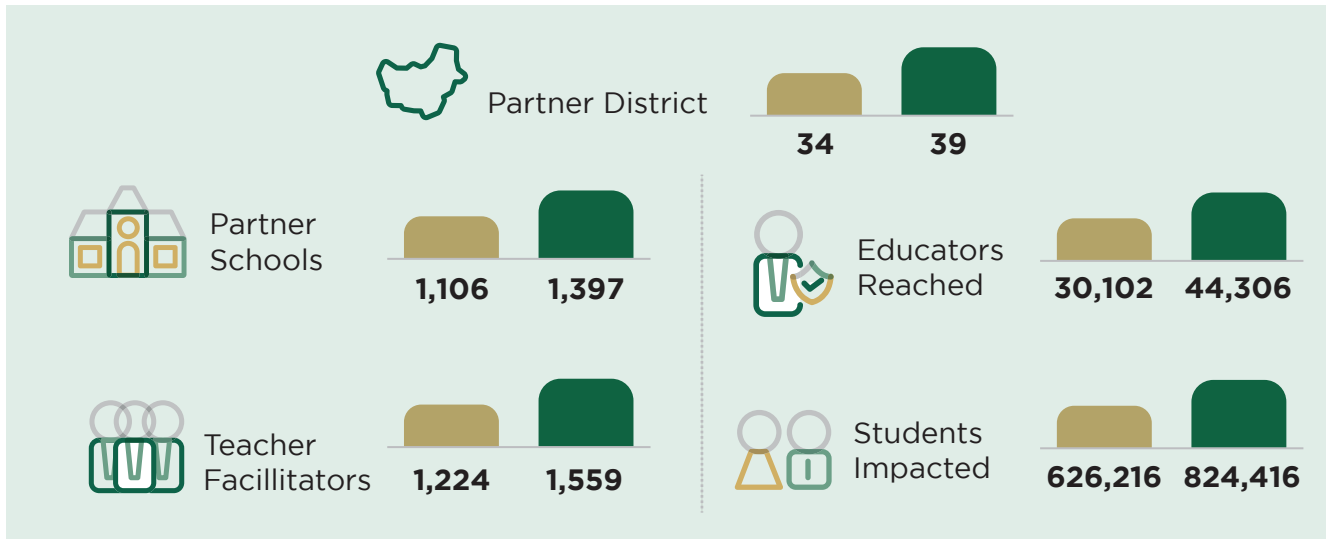


Teacher Education Strengthening

PINTAR Program continues to grow each year impacting more educators and students. The cumulative figure as of 31 December 2021:



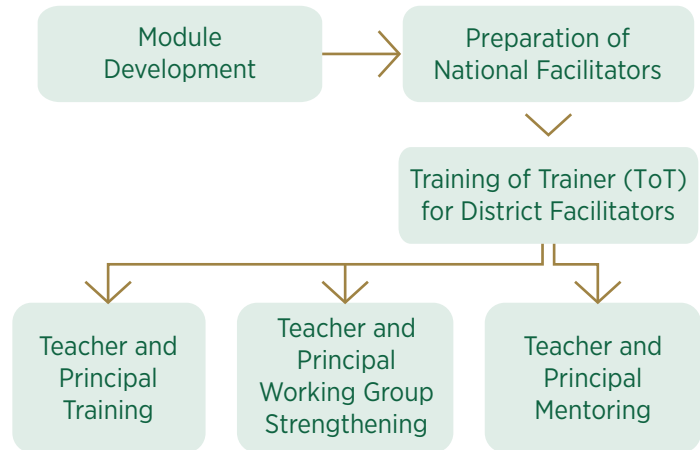

School Improvement

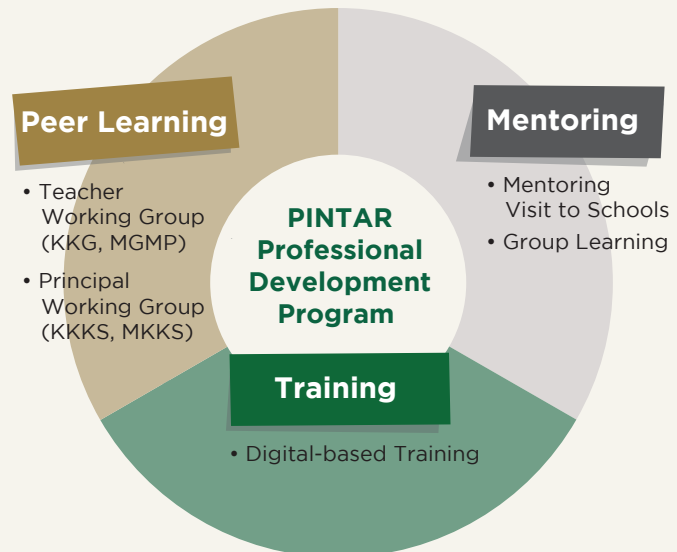
At school level, PINTAR program brings quality learning by:

- Training and mentoring teachers on the pedagogical skills to facilitate active learning that develops students' High Order Thinking Skills (HOTS).
- Training and mentoring principals on school-based management and leadership skills to bring about transparent and participative school planning, reading culture, and conducive learning environment.
- Building parent awareness and participation in student learning at home and school.

The program uses Training of Training (ToT) approach to deliver program at scale.



The program combines digital-based training, mentoring, and peer learning to ensure teachers and principals master and practice the new skills

We offer two types of training programs with distinct learning journeys for educators with different profiles, for the more independent learners and those who need more guidance.

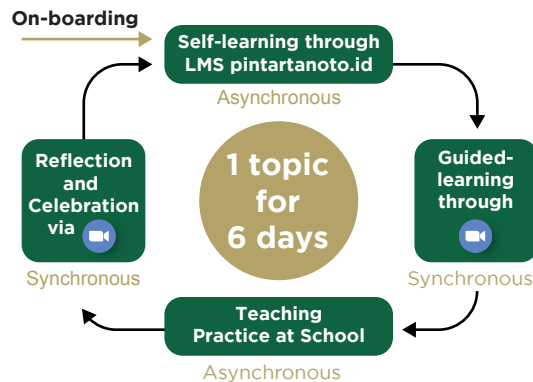

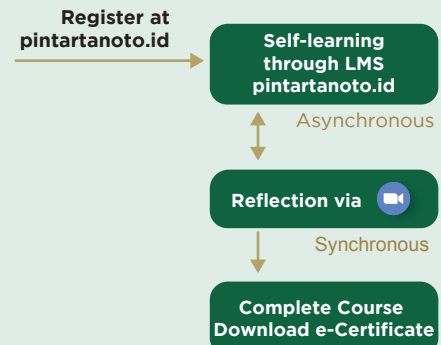

School Improvement

PINTAR Program encourages students to participate actively in the learning. We introduce teachers to the MIKiR framework that can guide them to prepare for interactive and stimulating lessons

M***Mengalami (Experiencing)***

Student constructs knowledge by conducting hands-on experiment and authentic problem-solving project.

I***Interaksi (Interacting)***

Student sharpens their understanding through discussion and group work with their peers.

Ki***Komunikasi (Communicating)***

Student grows their confidence and communication skills by presenting their work to the teachers and classmates.

R***Refleksi (Reflecting)***

Student reflects on the process and result to conclude the learning of the day.

Parent Engagement



Through “Orang Tua Sahabat Anak Belajar” campaign, PINTAR Program provides parents with tips on how to support children learning at home. The materials such as short animation videos, flyers, and toolkits were distributed through social media and the Parent Ambassadors – selected parent leaders who help to coordinate the program in school.



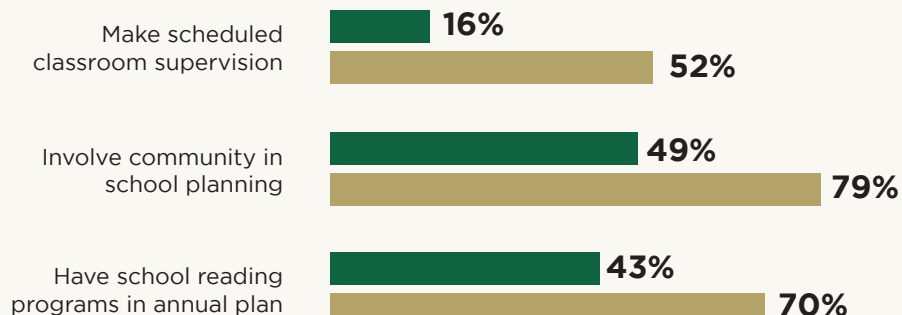

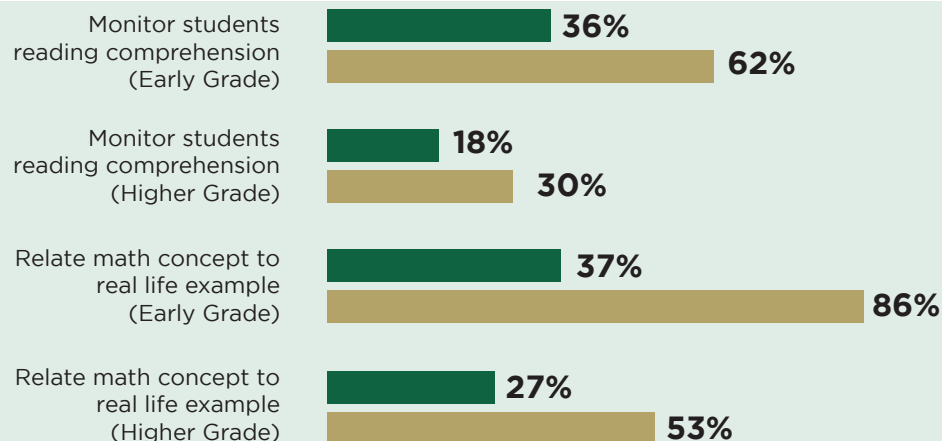

Impact of PINTAR Training based on 2018-19 vs 2021 studies:

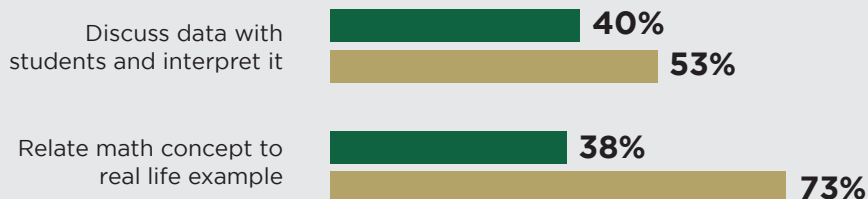
% of **principals**

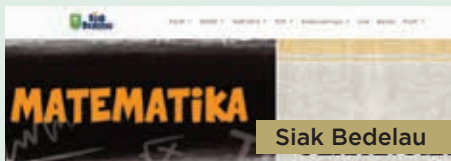
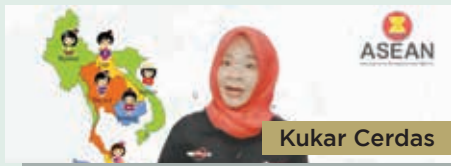
Technical Assistance to Government

PINTAR Program supports partner governments in building a sustainable and effective education ecosystem. We build the capacity of the people and the system to make evidence-based and impact-driven development plan.



Distance Learning Support

We provide technical assistance to our partner Education Offices to design and run contextualized innovation at their districts. For example, during the pandemic, we supported the sharing of best practices among teachers and principals through the digital platforms established by the government of Kutai Kartanegara, Kendal, Tebo and Siak.



Planning Support

We accompany our government partners during the process of annual, mid-term and long-term development planning. In partnership with leading universities, we facilitate workshop, mentoring and consultation with experts to internalize Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) indicators in the government system to sustain education quality sustainably.



Studies

We commission for studies, surveys, and mapping exercises then present them to policymakers as a consideration to make sound plan and prioritize actions.



Teacher Education Strengthening

Quality pre-service teacher training programs ensure the supply of competent teachers into the education system. PINTAR Program supports Teacher Education through 2 main programs:

Teacher Training Institute (TTI) Development Program

we improve teacher education at the undergraduate level.

Teaching Practicum (PLP) Strengthening

- Training lecturers and mentor teachers on the best practices in teaching practicum
- Fostering the collaboration between the lecturers and mentor teachers when coaching students majoring in Education

Teaching Quality Measurement Project

- Developing indicators and tools to measure the teaching quality in the Teacher Education programs
- Building the capacity of Quality Assurance Team to collect and analyze data on teaching quality

Pendidikan Profesi Guru (PPG) Strengthening Program

we support the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology's in the revitalization of teacher certification program or PPG - the one-year teacher preparation program.

Teacher Certification Program (PPG) Strengthening

- Training lecturers and mentor teachers in PPG-implementing institutes on the best practices in teaching practicum
- Fostering the collaboration between the lecturers and mentor teachers when coaching teacher candidates

Technical Assistance to the MoECRT regarding revitalization of Teacher Certification

- Providing input on the curriculum of Teacher Certification Program
- Commissioning the studies on Teacher Induction Program

PINTAR-Penggerak

Under a self-funding scheme, PINTAR Program participates in the Program Organisasi Penggerak (POP), the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology's initiative to gather proven best practices from development partners.

Through PINTAR Penggerak Program, we further adopted and expanded the lessons learned from existing partner districts under

PINTAR Program to advance student literacy, numeracy, and science in 4 districts recommended by the Ministry.
